The unique role played by the faculty member in enhancing the conceptual clarity and thinking ability of students, communication skills, punctuality and subject knowledge, updation in IT and current trends, care and concern of the faculty for the students are analysed through 10 queries on a self-administered five point scale of excellent, very good, good, fair and unsatisfied. These were analyzed and the results implied that the highest scoring was gained by the faculty's ability in imparting conceptual knowledge to the students, shared by Overall performance.

The results also show that the faculty members IT skills require improvisation as it has received least scores: 54.3% compared to all other variables.

Computer Lab and Other Lab Facilities:

When students are asked whether there are adequate computers in computer labs, infrastructural facilities in other labs are sufficient, they were assertive to this. Timely completion of assignments and records, declaration of test results within a time span of two weeks were all positively looked into by students and most of them opined that they would recommend others to enroll in this institution.

Interpretation

The faculty when questioned whether the syllabus framed is abreast with recent advancements, whether it is suitable for higher studies, are the theoretical concepts matching with the application aspects, more than 50% of the teacher respondents strongly agreed and a very meager number (1.3%) of them disagreed. The responses for the program outcomes and course outcomes being specific and precise, specificity in learning outcomes, introduction of novelties in teaching-learning techniques were perceived to be perfect by the teachers as most of

them strongly agreed to it. More than half of the teachers strongly agreed that Internal Assessment Tests were conducted regularly. Most of the faculty members were of the opinion that the work environment gives importance to human values, ethics and professionalism.

Whether human values are incorporated in the syllabus, whether the syllabus is helpful for the development of inner qualities and skills of students received positive responses from the alumni.

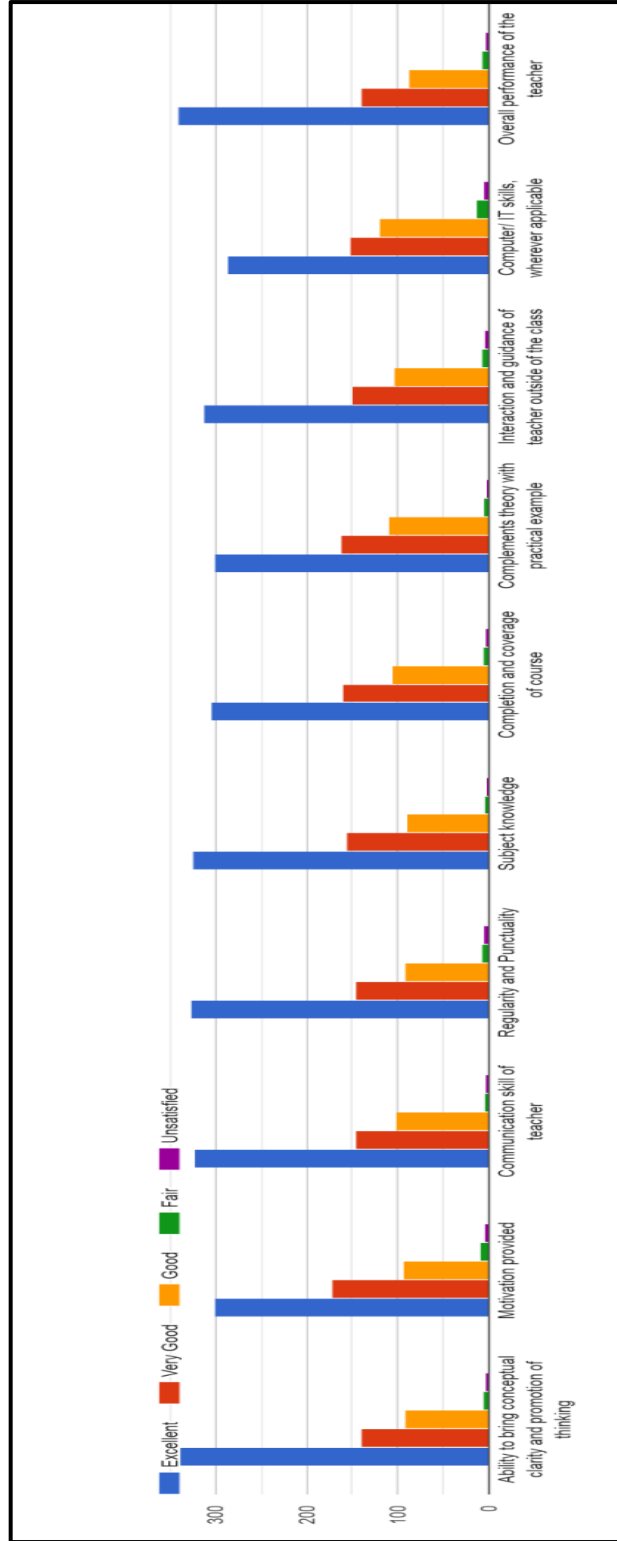

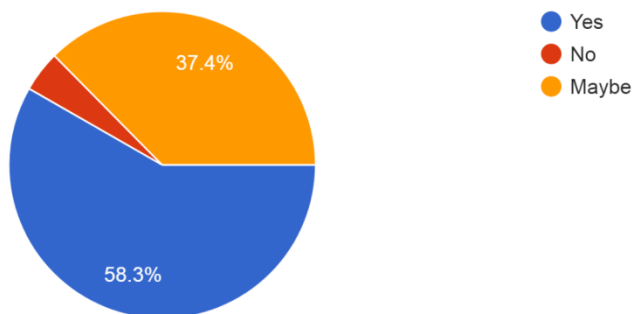

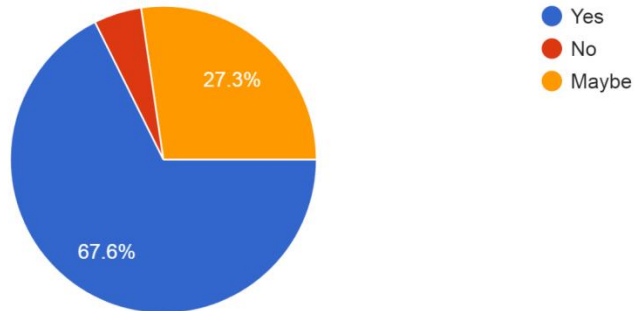

Do you think that the current syllabus enables the development of inner qualities and skills of students?

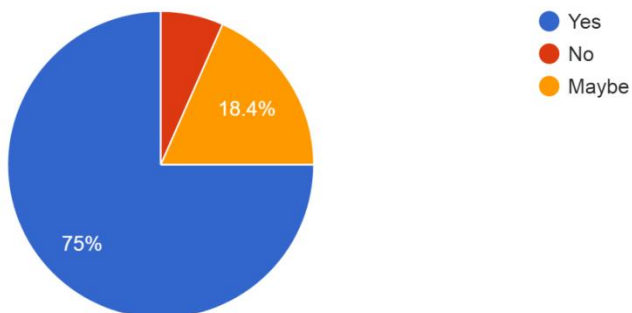

Performance of Faculty Members

The unique role played by the faculty member in enhancing the conceptual clarity of students, communication skills, punctuality, subject knowledge, updation in IT and current trends, care and concern of the faculty for the students are analysed through 10 queries on a self-administered five point scale of excellent, very good, good, fair and unsatisfied. Analysis showed that highest scoring was gained by the faculty's ability in imparting conceptual knowledge to the students. The results also show that the IT skills of the faculty members require improvisation as it has received least scores: 41% compared to all other variables.

Infrastructural Facilities

When the alumni were asked whether the computers in computer labs, infrastructural facilities in other labs were sufficient, they strongly agreed to it. Timely completion of assignments and records, declaration of test results within a time span of two weeks were all positively looked into by the respondents and most of them replied that they would recommend others to enroll in this institution.
