Focussing passionately on research, he has taken up three major projects costing rupees six to ten lakhs each from a well-known organization.

He has to his credit a book, besides editing two books. Twelve scholars have completed their MPhil course; three are doing their doctorate with financial assistance from reputed institutions under his guidance. He has written 14 articles in edited books and eight articles in journals, covering a wide range of topics, in a short period of eight years. He has also four publications in Tamil. Invited as a resource person in many Seminars. He has also presented forty seven papers in them.

He has organised a two-Day National Seminar on Economic Growth and Social Inequalities and a Ten - Day Research Methodology Workshop in Social Sciences for PhD scholars in 2016 both sponsored by ICSSR.

Dr V SIVASANKAR has widened his areas of interest to include Economic Discrimination, Labour Economics and Development Economics. He has conducted a field research on Slavery in Export Market in Garment Industry in Tamil Nadu (2010) for Centre for Education and Communication, New Delhi. He had taken up four more high profile field researches as well.

He received the Dr V Mohananasundaram Best Paper Award at the 32nd Annual Conference of AET held at Gobi Arts and Science College, in November 2011.
