The conference went well. In the history of Muthurangam Government Arts college, Vellore, the first ever National Level Conference organised by Department of Library.

The conference has witnessed overwhelming responses from academicians, Librarians from various colleges and Research scholars. There were about 55 delegates that represented from various states such as Karnataka, Andra Pradesh and Tamil nadu. Out of 55 delegates, 37 delegates have presented research papers and all of them were unique and very informative. The Registration started from 9.00am to 10a.m. The inaugural session of the conference on 21st July started at 10a.m. In the beginning of conference, Dr. K. Kumaresan had delivered a welcome speech. A brief note about the objective of conference was conferred by convenor of conference. Followed by, the Conference was headed by Dr. Sugirtha Rani Julina Principal and Regional Joint Director (In charge) vellore Division and Dr. Ezhilan, Controller of Examination have delivered a presidential address and they highlighted about the conference.

Then, Prof .Dr. Maria Antony Raj, Principal, Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur, who delivered a special address in the conference, has motivated and also stressed that the 21st century libraries have opened the door for providing knowledgeable human resources. The knowledgeable human resource is meant that who would give an answer to the user's questions.

Mr. Venkataramani, Ex- Documentation officer / Library Facility, ISRO, Sriharikota, Andra Pradesh had delivered a key note address. He underlined that the conference topic was energetic and it has also embedded about the issues of libraries in upcoming days.

efforts taken, in spite of being alone in the Library Department, in bringing resource person across the state altogether are very difficult task.


The second part of the event began after a tea-break. The first technical session —1 had two invited speakers. The first technical session was chaired by Dr. Mahindra Jadhav, Librarian, Indian Institute of Technology- Madras, Chennai and Repporteured by Dr. Kothandaraman, College Librarian, Government Arts College (Men), Autonomous, Nandanam, Chennai -06. They were facilitated with memento and shawl by Dr. K. Kumaresan, Convenor and Dr.Sreedaran, Member- Library Advisory Committee, Associate Professor —Department of Commerce. The main theme of the session was "Library and Information Sources and Services". The session had around 8 papers. The chair person of the session emphasised that the sources were transformed in to various format which is boundless. He threw a light on how Indian Institute of Technology—Chennai library handles the electronic resources while delivering service to users. A delegate stressed that acquisition, managing of electronic resources in academic libraries faces a big challenge. The session was quite flourishing and the participants were gripped by the brief speeches of chair person and rapporteur.

The second technical session of the event was resumed at 1.45pm after the lunch break 12.45pm to 1.45pm. The session was chaired by Dr. B. Jeyapragash, Asst. Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli and the rapporteur was Dr. R. Senthil Kumar, Senior Librarian, Christian Medical College, Vellore. They were facilitated with memento and shawl by Dr. K. Kumaresan, Convenor. There were 28 papers being contributed for this session. The main theme of the second technical session was Library Information tools and techniques and Library Trends Dr. B. Jeyapragash spoke on "Library recent trends and technologies" He focused on the recent technologies, which are now playing important role in information management that is collection, storage, organization, retrieval and dissemination of information. He also conveyed that the technology adopted libraries can do better management of information and also able to provide the library services on time without any geographical barrier. Dr. Ramasamy, one of the presenter, questioned that the utility of resources are seems to be remain questionable. Finally, Dr. Senthil Kumar,rapporteur answered that the proper guidance to the users are required in order to achieve the usage of e-resources effectively.

The third technical session started at 3pm and ended up at 4.15pm. The session had 2 invited speakers – Dr. Vijayakumar K. P., Former Associate Professor and Head, Department of Library and Information Science & Hon.Director, Centre for Information Literacy Studies, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram, Mr. Janarthanan, Librarian, Madras Medical College, Chennai. They were facilitated with memento and shawl by Dr. Siva Sankar, Asst.professor, Department of Economics. The session main theme was "Library access, space and preservation". Dr. Vijayakumar underlined that libraries over the centuries have been designed to hold the collective intellectual wealth of the times. And he also pointed out that they have been symbols of wealth and power, as well as centers of enlightenment and education. Mr. Janarthanan highlighted that space constrains are real challenges for libraries.

Dr. K. Kumaresan, the convenor of conference thanked all the distinguished speakers for sparing their valuable time and making the event a grand success.
