The Library subscribes journals and magazines include national and international print versions.

The Library has separate section for magazine and journals. The Library is now using a dual token card system and automated system for library housekeeping function. The library has digital library 17 computers with BSNL fiber-optic internet connectivity. The total number of library books is 56817 and library subscribes 6293 e-journals, 195809 e-books through N-LIST. Under the state fund scheme, an amount of Rs.194000 is received.

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Memoranda of Understanding An M.o.U was signed by the Post graduate Department of Business administration with Audacious Dreams Foundation, TamilNadu and organised a training program collaboratively with 100 Participants. The Post Graduate and research department of Commerce had signed an M.o.U with Arignar Anna Arts College, Walaja.
